1 Section 1. Section 233.1, subsection 2, Code 1985, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 2. To send, or cause to be sent, any such child to a-house
4 ~~of-prostitution-or-to~~ any place where intoxicating liquors are
5 unlawfully sold or unlawfully kept for sale, or to any policy
6 shop, or to any gambling place, or to any public poolroom
7 where beer is sold, or to induce any such child to go to any
8 such places, knowing them to be such.

9 Sec. 2. NEW SECTION. 233.6 CONTRIBUTING TO PROSTITUTION.

10 A person who sends, or causes to be sent, a minor to a
11 prostitute commits a serious misdemeanor. However, this
12 section does not apply to those persons who send, or cause to
13 be sent, a minor to a place of prostitution for the purpose of
14 becoming a prostitute, but rather these persons are subject to
15 section 725.3, subsection 2.

16 Sec. 3. Section 725.3, Code 1985, is amended to read as
17 follows:

18 725.3 PANDERING.

19 1. A person who persuades or arranges for another, not a
20 minor, to become an inmate of a brothel, or to become a
21 prostitute, such person not having previously engaged in
22 prostitution, or to return to the practice of prostitution
23 after having abandoned it, or who keeps or maintains a brothel
24 or who knowingly takes a share in the income from a brothel,
25 commits a class "D" felony.

26 2. A person who persuades or arranges for a minor to
27 become an inmate of a brothel, or to become a prostitute, such
28 minor not having previously engaged in prostitution, or to
29 return to the practice of prostitution after having abandoned
30 it, commits a class "C" felony.

EXPLANATION

32 This bill creates the offense of contributing to prostitu-
33 tion and provides that a person who sends a minor to a
34 prostitute, commits a serious misdemeanor (previously a simple
35 misdemeanor).

1 The bill also provides that a person who persuades or
2 causes a minor to become a prostitute commits a class "C"
3 felony (previously a class "D" felony).

21 1. A person who persuades, arranges, coerces, or

23 prostitute, to return to the practice of prostitution
24 after having abandoned it, or keeps or maintains any
25 premises for the purposes of prostitution or takes a
26 share in the income from such premises knowing the
27 character and content of such income, commits a class
28 "D" felony.

29 2. A person who persuades, arranges, coerces, or
30 otherwise causes a minor to become a prostitute, to
31 return to the practice of prostitution after having
32 abandoned it, or keeps or maintains any premises for
33 the purpose of prostitution involving minors or
34 knowingly shares in the income from such premises
35 knowing the character and content of such income,
36 commits a class "C" felony."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 233.1, subsection 2, Code 1985, is amended by striking the subsection and inserting the following new subsection:

NEW SUBSECTION. 2. To knowingly send, cause to be sent, or induce to go, any child under the age of eighteen to any of the following:

- a. A brothel or other premises used for the purposes of prostitution, with the intent that the child engage the services of a prostitute.
- b. An unlicensed premises where alcoholic liquor, wine, or beer is unlawfully sold or kept for sale.
- c. Any premises the use of which constitutes a violation of sections 725.5, 725.10, or 725.11.

Sec. 2. Section 725.3, Code 1985, is amended by striking the section and inserting the following new section:

725.3 PANDERING.

1. A person who persuades, arranges, coerces, or otherwise causes another, not a minor, to become a prostitute, to return to the practice of prostitution after having abandoned it, or keeps or maintains any premises for the purposes of prostitution or takes a share in the income from such premises knowing the character and content of such income, commits a class "D" felony.
2. A person who persuades, arranges, coerces, or otherwise causes a minor to become a prostitute, to return to the practice of prostitution after having abandoned it, or keeps

or maintains any premises for the purpose of prostitution involving minors or knowingly shares in the income from such premises knowing the character and content of such income, commits a class "C" felony.
