3 lowing new unnumbered paragraph:

4 NEW UNNUMBERED PARAGRAPH. For purposes of this section,
5 the life cycle costs of American motor vehicles shall be re-
6 duced by five percent in order to determine if the motor
7 vehicle is comparable to foreign made motor vehicles.
8 American motor vehicles includes those vehicles manufactured
9 in this state and those vehicles in which at least seventy
10 percent of the value of the motor vehicle was manufactured in
11 North America and at least fifty percent of the motor vehicle
12 sales of the manufacturer are in North America. In
13 determining the life cycle costs of a motor vehicle, the costs
14 shall be determined on the basis of the bid price, the resale
15 value, and the operating costs based upon a useable life of
16 five years or seventy-five thousand miles, whichever occurs
17 first.

18 EXPLANATION

19 The bill provides that the life cycle costs of American
20 made motor vehicles shall be reduced by five percent for com-
21 parison purposes with products of foreign business. The bill
22 also defines American made products and specifies the factors
23 to be used in computing life cycle costs for motor vehicles.

RELATING TO THE PURCHASES OF AMERICAN MADE PRODUCTS AND PURCHASES FROM AMERICAN BASED BUSINESSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 18.3, subsection 1, Code 1985, is amended by inserting after unnumbered paragraph 2 the following new unnumbered paragraph:

NEW UNNUMBERED PARAGRAPH. For purposes of this section, the life cycle costs of American motor vehicles shall be reduced by five percent in order to determine if the motor vehicle is comparable to foreign made motor vehicles. American motor vehicles includes those vehicles manufactured in this state and those vehicles in which at least seventy percent of the value of the motor vehicle was manufactured in the United States or Canada and at least fifty percent of the motor vehicle sales of the manufacturer are in the United States or Canada. In determining the life cycle costs of a motor vehicle, the costs shall be determined on the basis of the bid price, the resale value, and the operating costs based upon a useable life of five years or seventy-five thousand miles, whichever occurs first.

Sec. 2. Section 18.6, Code 1985, is amended by adding the following new subsection:
