1 Section 1. Section 20.6, subsection 3, Code 1985, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 3. Maintain, after consulting with employee organizations
4 and public employers, a list of qualified persons
5 representative of the public to be available to serve as
6 mediators, fact-finding representatives, and arbitrators, and
7 establish their compensation rates. The board shall include
8 on all lists of qualified mediators, fact-finding
9 representatives, and arbitrators, the names of residents of
10 this state who are qualified as mediators, fact-finding
11 representatives, and arbitrators, and shall give preference to
12 the residents of this state in the appointment of mediators,
13 fact-finding representatives, and arbitrators pursuant to this
14 chapter.

15 Sec. 2. There is appropriated from the general fund of the
16 state for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1986, and ending
17 June 30, 1987, to the public employment relations board, the
18 following amount, or so much thereof as is necessary:

25 EXPLANATION

26 This bill requires the public employment relations board to
27 include qualified Iowans on all lists of mediators, fact-
28 finding representatives, and arbitrators, and to give
29 preference to Iowans in appointing mediators, fact-finding
30 representatives, and arbitrators. The bill also appropriates
31 \$10,000 to the board for the 1986-1987 fiscal year for the
32 training of residents of this state as mediators, fact-finding
33 representatives, and arbitrators.
