A BILL FOR

1 An Act to appropriate certain revenues from the state lottery, to
 2 establish an educational excellence account and distribute
 3 moneys from it to school districts, and to provide an
 4 effective date.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. 1985 Iowa Acts, chapter 33, section 301,
2 subsection 1, paragraphs a and b, are amended to read as
3 follows:

4 a. The first eleven one million ninety-two eight hundred
5 forty-two thousand (1,842,000) dollars to the "Jobs Now
6 Capitals" account.

7 b. After the allotment in paragraph "a", ten million
8 (10,000,000) dollars to the "Community Economic Betterment"
9 account, eight million five hundred thousand (8,500,000)
10 dollars to the "Jobs Now" account, and twelve million five
11 hundred thousand (12,500,000) dollars to the "Education and
12 Agriculture Research and Development" account and nine million
13 two hundred fifty thousand (9,250,000) dollars to the
14 "Educational Excellence" account.

15 Sec. 2. 1985 Iowa Acts, chapter 33, section 301, is
16 amended by inserting the following new subsection after
17 subsection 4:

18 NEW SUBSECTION. 4A. There is appropriated from the
19 allotment made to the educational excellence account under
20 subsection 1 for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1985 and
21 ending June 30, 1986 to the office of state comptroller the
22 sum of nine million two hundred fifty thousand (9,250,000)
23 dollars to be distributed to school districts in an equal
24 amount per pupil on the basis of the district's budget
25 enrollment for the budget year beginning July 1, 1985 under
26 section 442.4. The payments are miscellaneous income for
27 purposes of chapter 442.

28 Sec. 3. 1985 Iowa Acts, chapter 33, section 301,
29 subsection 5, paragraph a, is amended by striking the
30 paragraph.

31 Sec. 4. 1985 Iowa Acts, chapter 33, section 301,
32 subsection 6, is amended to read as follows:

33 6. If the moneys to be allotted to the economic betterment
34 account, jobs now account or, education and agriculture
35 research and development account is, or educational excellence

1 account are less than the amount specified in subsection 1,
2 paragraph "b", the moneys appropriated to the funds, agencies,
3 boards, or commissions for the purposes specified in
4 subsection 2, 3, or 4, or 4A, as applicable, shall be reduced
5 by the same percentage decrease in the appropriate allotment.

6 Sec. 5. 1985 Iowa Acts, chapter 33, section 302,
7 subsection 1, paragraph a, is amended to read as follows:

8 a. In each of the fiscal years beginning July 1, 1986, and
9 July 1, 1987, July 1, 1988, and July 1, 1989, the first ten
10 one million two-hundred-fifty-thousand (1,000,000) dollars, in
11 the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1988, the first three million
12 two-hundred-fifty-thousand dollars and in the fiscal year
13 beginning July 1, 1989, the first one million dollars to the
14 jobs now capitals account.

15 In each of the fiscal years beginning July 1, 1986 and July
16 1, 1987, nine million two hundred fifty thousand (9,250,000)
17 dollars, and in the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1988, two
18 million two hundred fifty thousand (2,250,000) dollars to the
19 educational excellence account.

20 Sec. 6. 1985 Iowa Acts, chapter 33, section 302, is
21 amended by adding the following new subsection after
22 subsection 4:

23 NEW SUBSECTION. 4A. There are appropriated moneys in the
24 educational excellence account for each of the fiscal years
25 beginning July 1, 1986, July 1, 1987, and July 1, 1988 to the
26 office of state comptroller to be distributed quarterly to
27 school districts in an equal amount per pupil on the basis of
28 the district's budget enrollment for the budget year under
29 section 442.4. The payments are miscellaneous income for
30 purposes of chapter 442.

31 Sec. 7. 1985 Iowa Acts, chapter 33, section 302,
32 subsection 5, paragraph a, is amended by striking the
33 paragraph.

34 Sec. 8. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance,
35 takes effect from and after its publication in The Sioux City

1 Journal, a newspaper published in Sioux City, Iowa, and in The
2 Daily Reporter, a newspaper published in Sioux City, Iowa.

EXPLANATION

4 This bill appropriates the world trade center moneys from
5 the lottery revenues to an educational excellence account to
6 be distributed by the state comptroller to the school
7 districts on the basis of their budget enrollment for the
8 budget year.

9 The Act takes effect upon its publication.
