A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to the offense of prostitution and providing
2 penalties.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

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SF 4

1 Section 1. Section 725.1, Code 1987, is amended to read as
2 follows:

3 725.1 PROSTITUTION.

4 1. A person who sells or offers for sale the person's
5 services as a partner in a sex act, or who purchases or offers
6 to purchase such services, commits an-aggravated a serious
7 misdemeanor.

8 2. A person who, in a public place, sells or offers for
9 sale the person's services as a partner in a sex act, or who
10 purchases or offers to purchase such services while in a
11 public place, commits an aggravated misdemeanor.

12 3. A person convicted pursuant to subsections 1 or 2 shall
13 be deemed to have consented to a medical examination for
14 venereal disease, and the court shall order the person to
15 submit to the examination at the person's expense. Where,
16 pursuant to ordered examination, a venereal disease is found
17 to be present, the court shall order the person to submit to
18 treatment of the disease at the person's expense.

19 EXPLANATION

20 This bill provides that the penalty for prostitution in a
21 nonpublic place is a serious misdemeanor and that the penalty
22 for prostitution in a public place is an aggravated
23 misdemeanor.

24 The bill also provides that a conviction for prostitution
25 will be deemed consent of the person to submit to a medical
26 examination for venereal disease.

27 The bill also requires the court to order submission to
28 examination and, if venereal disease is found to be present,
29 to order submission to treatment. Both ordered examinations
30 and treatments are to be at the person's own expense.

 12 department of public health, and the court shall order
 13 the person to submit to the examination at the
 14 person's expense. Where, pursuant to ordered
 15 examination, a sexually transmitted disease is found
 16 to be present, the court shall order the person to
 17 submit to treatment of the disease. Persons
 18 identified as infected with the human immunodeficiency
 19 virus are subject to section 135H.7 as enacted in
 20 Senate File 2157 if that bill is enacted by the
 21 general assembly. A person required to undergo
 22 examination or treatment for disease under this
 23 section who does not possess sufficient income or
 24 estate to pay the costs of the examination or
 25 treatment in whole or in part shall be considered a
 26 state patient and the costs of the examination or
 27 treatment shall be paid as provided in section
 28 252.25."
