25 a one hundred mile radius of the retail seller's place of  
26 business.

- (3) From one farm site to another farm site.

PARAGRAPH DIVIDED. For the purpose of this subsection the term and sections 321.383 and 321.453, "farm site" means a place or location at which vehicles principally designed for
