1 An Act relating to the purposes for which community economic  
2 betterment funds may be expended.  
3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Amend Senate File 402 as follows:  
2 1. Page 1, by striking lines 1 through 22 and  
3 inserting the following:  
4 "Section 1. Section 99E.31, subsection 2,  
5 paragraph b, Code Supplement 1987, is amended to read  
6 as follows:  
7 b. Only a political subdivision of the state may  
8 apply to receive funds for any of the above purposes.  
9 The political subdivision shall make application to  
10 the department of economic development specifying the  
11 purpose for which the funds will be used. In ranking  
12 applications for funds, the department shall consider  
13 ~~a variety of factors including 7 but not limited to~~  
14 give equal consideration to the following factors:".  
15 2. Page 1, line 23, by inserting after the word  
16 "Code" the following: "Supplement".  
17 3. Page 1, line 27, by inserting after the word  
18 "Code" the following: "Supplement".  
19 4. Page 1, line 29, by striking the word "h." and  
20 inserting the following: "i."

1 Section 1. Section 99E.31, subsection 2, unnumbered  
2 paragraph 2, Code 1987, is amended to read as follows:

3 Only a political subdivision of the state may apply to  
4 receive funds for any of the above purposes. The political  
5 subdivision shall make application to the commission  
6 specifying the purpose for which the funds will be used. In  
7 ranking applications for funds, the commission shall **consider**  
8 give equal consideration to the proportion of political  
9 subdivision match to be provided, the proportion of private  
10 contributions to be provided, the total number of jobs to be  
11 created, the recapture, if any, of these funds by the  
12 political subdivision that will occur, level of need in the  
13 political subdivision, and impact of proposed project on the  
14 economy of the political subdivision. The commission shall  
15 not provide more than one million dollars for any project,  
16 unless at least two-thirds of the members of the commission  
17 vote for providing more. However, after the first ten million  
18 dollars in the community economic betterment account have been  
19 provided to political subdivisions, the amount that may be  
20 provided by the commission for a project from additional  
21 moneys credited to that account is not subject to the one  
22 million dollar limitation.

23 Sec. 2. Section 99E.32, subsection 2, paragraph d, Code  
24 1987, is amended to read as follows:

25 d. Site development ~~or-infrastructure~~ costs directly  
26 related to a project resulting in new employment.

27 Sec. 3. Section 99E.32, subsection 2, Code 1987, is  
28 amended by adding the following new lettered paragraph:

29 NEW LETTERED PARAGRAPH. h. Public works and facilities  
30 which are defined as an essential corporate purpose or a  
31 general corporate purpose in section 384.24, subsection 3 or  
32 4.

33 EXPLANATION

34 This bill provides that community economic betterment funds  
35 can be used to fund any purpose listed as an essential

1 corporate purpose or general corporate purpose for city  
2 bonding purposes. The bill also provides that the Iowa  
3 economic development board give equal consideration to the  
4 criteria listed to determine the priority or ranking of  
5 applications for funding.
