AN ACT

RELATING TO ISSUANCE OF CERTIFICATES OF INSPECTION FOR BOILERS USED ON TOURIST RAILROADS OR TOURIST TRAINS AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:
