1 Section 1. NEW SECTION. 294A.25 APPROPRIATION.

2 For each fiscal year commencing with the fiscal year  
3 beginning July 1, 1987, there is appropriated from the general  
4 fund of the state to the educational excellence fund to be  
5 allocated in the manner provided in this chapter the amount of  
6 sixty-seven million seven hundred eighty-nine thousand nine  
7 hundred (67,789,900) dollars.

8 Sec. 2. NEW SECTION. 294A.26 COVERAGE OF CERTAIN  
9 TEACHERS.

10 For each fiscal year commencing with the fiscal year  
11 beginning July 1, 1987, there is appropriated from the general  
12 fund of the state to the department of education the following  
13 amounts:

14 1. The amount of ninety-four thousand six hundred (94,600)  
15 dollars to be paid to the state board of regents for  
16 distribution to certificated classroom teachers at the Iowa  
17 braille and sightsaving school and the Iowa school for the  
18 deaf for payments of minimum salary supplements for phase I  
19 and payments for phase II based upon the average yearly  
20 enrollment at each school as determined by the state board.

21 2. The amount of one hundred fifteen thousand five hundred  
22 (115,500) dollars to be paid to the department of human  
23 services for distribution to its certificated classroom  
24 teachers at institutions under the control of the department  
25 of human services for payments for phase II based upon the  
26 average student yearly enrollment at each institution as  
27 determined by the department of human services.

28 Sec. 3. NEW SECTION. 256.22 APPROPRIATION.

29 For each of the fiscal years beginning July 1, 1988, July  
30 1, 1989, and July 1, 1990, there is appropriated from the  
31 general fund of the state to the department of education the  
32 amount of two million (2,000,000) dollars, or so much thereof  
33 as may be necessary, to be distributed to school districts for  
34 teachers with sabbaticals approved by the department under  
35 section 256.21. Notwithstanding section 8.31, moneys

1 appropriated for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1988 may be  
2 allocated to the department of education at any time on or  
3 after June 1, 1988.

4 Sec. 4. NEW SECTION. 256.24 EDUCATIONAL EXPENSES FOR  
5 INDIANS.

6 The department of education shall provide moneys to pay the  
7 expense of educating Indian children residing in the Sac and  
8 Fox Indian settlement on land held in trust by the secretary  
9 of the interior of the United States in excess of federal  
10 moneys paid to the tribal council for educating the Indian  
11 children when moneys are appropriated for that purpose. The  
12 tribal council shall administer the moneys distributed to it  
13 by the department and shall submit an annual report to the  
14 department on the expenditure of the moneys.

15 Sec. 5. There is appropriated from the general fund of the  
16 state to the department of education for the fiscal year  
17 beginning July 1, 1987 and ending June 30, 1988, one hundred  
18 thousand (100,000) dollars, or so much thereof as is  
19 necessary, for educational aid to Indians under section  
20 256.24.

21 Sec. 6. Sections 1 through 3 of this Act take effect only  
22 if House File 499, creating chapter 294A and an educational  
23 excellence trust fund and creating section 256.21 and a  
24 sabbatical program for teachers administered by the department  
25 of education, is enacted by the Seventy-second General  
26 Assembly, 1987 Session, and becomes law.

27 EXPLANATION

28 This bill appropriates moneys to fund the teacher salary  
29 increases provided in House File 499. It also appropriates  
30 money to improve salaries of teachers at the Iowa braille and  
31 sight-saving school and the Iowa school for the deaf and  
32 institutions under the department of human services and to  
33 fund the teacher sabbatical program contained in House File  
34 499.

35 The bill also provides for the appropriation of money to

1 the department of education to be used by the Sac and Fox  
2 tribal council for the costs of educating Indian children on  
3 the Sac and Fox settlement above the federal moneys received  
4 for that purpose and appropriates one hundred thousand dollars  
5 for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1987.

7 from the general fund of the state to the educational  
8 excellence fund to be allocated to school districts  
9 and area education agencies by the department of

12 to meet the minimum salary requirements of this  
13 chapter for phase I, in an amount of thirty-eight
