AN ACT

ESTABLISHING THE ELIGIBILITY OF IOWANS FOR INCLUSION OF THEIR NAMES ON THE IOWA VIETNAM VETERANS MEMORIAL.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 35A.6, Code 1987, is amended by adding the following new subsection:

NEW SUBSECTION. 4. Establish, by rule, the qualifications of Iowa veterans whose names are eligible for inclusion on the Iowa Vietnam veterans memorial. The qualifications adopted by the commission shall be the same qualifications, to the extent possible, as used for selecting veterans' names for inclusion
