1 An Act relating to and making appropriations to the Iowa law
2 enforcement academy.

1 Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund of
2 the state to the Iowa law enforcement academy for the fiscal
3 biennium beginning July 1, 1989, and ending June 30, 1991, the
4 following amounts, or so much thereof as is necessary, to be
5 used for the purposes designated:

6 For salaries, support, maintenance, and miscellaneous
7 purposes, including jailer training and technical assistance:
8 1989-90 FY \$ 773,012
9 1990-91 FY \$ 778,753

10 Sec. 2. Notwithstanding section 80B.11, subsection 5, dur-
11 ing the fiscal years beginning July 1, 1989, and July 1, 1990,
12 not more than one-half of the cost of providing cognitive and
13 psychological examinations of law enforcement officer
14 candidates may be charged for taking the examinations by the
15 Iowa law enforcement academy.

16 The Iowa law enforcement academy may also charge not more
17 than one-half of the cost of providing the ten-week course
18 which is designed to meet the minimum basic training require-
19 ments for a law enforcement officer.

20 Sec. 3. Section 80B.11, Code 1989, is amended by adding
21 the following new subsection:

22 NEW SUBSECTION. 8. Minimum standards for jailer training
23 and technical assistance, including certification standards
24 and jailer instructor standards.

25 EXPLANATION

26 The bill appropriates funds to the Iowa law enforcement
27 academy for the fiscal biennium beginning July 1, 1989, and
28 ending June 30, 1991.

29 New section 80B.11, subsection 8, gives the Iowa law
30 enforcement academy permanent statutory responsibility for
31 jailer training. The responsibility was transferred during
32 state reorganization through appropriation bill language only,
33 this corrects the situation.
