A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to and making appropriations to various education
2 agencies including the department of education.
3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

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SF 164

1 Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund of
2 the state to the department of education for the fiscal
3 biennium beginning July 1, 1989, and ending June 30, 1991, the
4 following amounts, or so much thereof as may be necessary, to
5 be used for the purposes designated:

6 1. GENERAL ADMINISTRATION

7 For salaries, support, maintenance, and miscellaneous
8 purposes:

20 Funds appropriated by this subsection are to be used for
21 aid to school districts for development and the conduct of
22 both continuing and new vocational programs, services, and
23 activities of vocational education through secondary schools,

25 vocational education programs, in accordance with chapter 258
26 and chapter 280A, and to purchase instructional equipment for
27 vocational and technical courses of instruction in those
28 schools.

 18 pursuant to this section and paid on or about August 15, 1990,
 19 and August 15, 1991, respectively.

20 Sec. 6. General state aid paid to merged areas under
 21 section 2 of this Act, for expenditures incurred during the
 22 fiscal biennium beginning July 1, 1989, and ending June 30,
 23 1991, shall be paid by the department of revenue and finance
 24 in installments due on or about November 15, February 15, and
 25 May 15 of that fiscal year. The payments received by merged
 26 areas on or about August 15 under sections 4 and 5 of this Act
 27 are accounts receivable for the previous fiscal year. The
 28 installments shall be as nearly equal as possible as
 29 determined by the department of management, taking into
 30 consideration the relative budget and cash position of the
 31 state resources.

32 Sec. 7. Notwithstanding section 8.33, one-half of the
 33 unencumbered or unobligated funds remaining on June 30, 1989,
 34 from the funds appropriated in 1988 Iowa Acts, chapter 1284,
 35 section 39, shall not revert to the general fund of the state

1 but shall be available for expenditure for the purposes for
2 which the funds were appropriated during the fiscal year
3 beginning July 1, 1989, and ending June 30, 1990.

4 Sec. 8.

5 a. Notwithstanding the appropriation provided in section
6 294A.25, subsection 1, there is appropriated from the general
7 fund of the state to the department of education, for the
8 fiscal year beginning July 1, 1989, and ending June 30, 1990,
9 the sum of ninety-two million four hundred fifty-two thousand
10 three hundred fifty dollars for the educational excellence
11 program.

12 b. Notwithstanding the amount to be distributed under
13 section 294A.25, subsection 4, there shall be distributed from
14 the appropriation made in paragraph "a", the sum of ninety-
15 four thousand three hundred sixty-five dollars to be used for
16 the purposes specified in section 256.30.

17 c. Of the amount appropriated in paragraph "a", three
18 hundred fifty thousand dollars, or so much thereof as is
19 necessary, shall be used, in addition to any other moneys
20 available for phase III, to increase by three and one-half
21 percent the amount of phase III moneys actually spent on
22 performance pay.

23 d. Notwithstanding section 8.33, one-fourth of the
24 unencumbered or unobligated funds remaining on June 30, 1990,
25 from the funds appropriated in paragraph "a" shall not revert
26 to the general fund of the state, but shall be available for
27 expenditure for the purposes listed in paragraph "a" during
28 the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1990, and ending June 30,
29 1991.

30 Sec. 9. Section 272A.5, Code 1989, is amended to read as
31 follows:

32 272A.5 ORGANIZATION AND RULES.

33 This ~~The~~ commission ~~shall have the authority to~~ may select
34 its own chairperson, establish procedures for its own
35 government and for the development of standards, adopt rules

1 and regulations, and secure legal and other services necessary
2 to its function. However, the governor shall appoint a
3 director of the commission and shall determine the director's
4 compensation.

5 Sec. 10. All federal grants to and the federal receipts of
6 agencies appropriated funds under sections 1 through 5 of this
7 Act, not otherwise appropriated, are appropriated for the
8 purposes set forth in the federal grants or receipts unless
9 otherwise provided by the general assembly.

10 Sec. 11. Moneys appropriated by sections 1 through 5 of
11 this Act shall not be used for capital improvements.

12 EXPLANATION

13 The bill appropriates funds to the department of education
14 for the fiscal biennium beginning July 1, 1989, and ending
15 June 30, 1991, and the fiscal biennium beginning July 1, 1991,
16 and ending June 30, 1992.

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
