1 Section 1. Section 118.8, unnumbered paragraph 2, Code
2 1989, is amended to read as follows:

3 The board shall adopt rules governing practical training
4 and education and may adopt as its rules criteria published by
5 a national certification body recognized by the board, subject
6 to exceptions as otherwise required by this section. The
7 board may accept the accreditation decisions of a national
8 accreditation body recognized by the board.

9 The board may waive the professional education requirements
10 for eligibility to take the examination if the applicant
11 demonstrates a specific and substantial hardship.

12 The board shall waive the professional education
13 requirements for eligibility to take the examination if the
14 applicant has been a continuous participant in a practical
15 training program under the direction of a registered architect
16 since January 1, 1970.

17 EXPLANATION

18 This bill relates to the eligibility of an applicant to
19 take the examination to become a registered architect. It
20 provides that the architectural examining board may waive the
21 professional education requirements if the applicant
22 demonstrates a specific and substantial hardship.

23 It also requires that the professional education
24 requirements be waived if the applicant has been a continuous
25 participant in a practical training program since January 1,
26 1970.
