1 Section 1. NEW SECTION. 714.7A VETERANS' GRAVE MARKERS.

2 A person commits theft in the third degree when the person
3 takes possession or control of a veteran's grave marker with
4 the intention to deprive the owner of the marker, regardless
5 of the value of the marker.

6 EXPLANATION

7 This bill creates a separate offense for the theft of a
8 veteran's grave marker, and punishes such offense as a third
9 degree theft, an aggravated misdemeanor, regardless of the
10 value of the marker.

PROHIBITING THE THEFT OF A VETERAN'S GRAVE MARKER, AND
PROVIDING A PENALTY.

I hereby certify that this bill originated in the Senate and is known as Senate File 360, Seventy-third General Assembly.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. NEW SECTION. 714.7A VETERANS' GRAVE MARKERS.

A person commits a simple misdemeanor when the person takes possession or control of a veteran's grave marker which was provided pursuant to section 250.16, with the intention to deprive the owner of the marker, regardless of the value of the marker.
