RELATING TO THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE MEDICAL ASSISTANCE ADVISORY COUNCIL.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 249A.4, subsection 8, unnumbered paragraph 1, Code 1989, is amended to read as follows:

Shall advise and consult at least semiannually with a council composed of the president, or the president's representative who is a member of the professional organization represented by the president, of the Iowa medical society, the Iowa osteopathic medical association, the Iowa state dental society, the Iowa state nurses association, the Iowa pharmacists association, the Iowa podiatry society, the Iowa optometric association, the community mental health centers association of Iowa, the Iowa psychological association, the Iowa hospital association, the Iowa osteopathic hospital association, opticians' association of Iowa, Inc., the Iowa hearing aid society, the Iowa speech, language, and hearing association, the Iowa health care association, the Iowa association for home care, the Iowa council of health care centers, and the Iowa association of homes for the aging, together with one person designated by the Iowa state board of chiropractic examiners; one state representative from each of the two major political parties appointed by the speaker of the house, one state senator from each of the two major political parties appointed by the majority leader of the senate, each for a term of two years; the president or the president's representative of the association for retarded citizens; four public representatives, appointed by the governor for staggered terms of two years each, none of whom shall be members of, or

practitioners of, or have a pecuniary interest in any of the professions or businesses represented by any of the several professional groups and associations specifically represented on the council under this subsection, and at least one of whom shall be a recipient of medical assistance; the director of public health, or a representative designated by the director, and the dean of the college of medicine, university of Iowa, or a representative designated by the dean.
