20 through a depositary.

FISCAL NOTE

A fiscal note for SENATE FILE 427 is hereby submitted pursuant to Joint Rule 17. Data used in developing this fiscal note is available from the Legislative Fiscal Bureau to members of the Legislature upon request.

Senate File 427 authorizes the collection of a writing fee for the sale of State Park User permits. The writing fee is fifty cents. If the permit is sold by a vendor other than a County Recorder or the Department of Natural Resources, the vendor may retain twenty-five cents and the County Recorder may retain the other twenty-five cents. If the permit is sold by a County Recorder, that office may retain the entire fifty cents. The cost of a State Park User permit is \$5.50.

Assumptions:

1. 166,500 annual State Park User permits were sold in FY 1988.
2. 83,000 were sold by County Recorders.
3. 6,500 were sold by vendors.
4. 77,000 were sold by the Department of Natural Resources.
5. Sales in future years will not differ significantly from FY 1988.
6. The price of the permit, including a writing fee, will remain at \$5.50.

Fiscal Effect:

Senate File 427 would reduce the income to the Park User Fee fund by an annual amount of \$44,000. County Recorders would receive \$42,500 of this amount, while the remainder would be retained by private vendors.
