3 NEW SUBSECTION. 16. The department shall issue without
4 fee a fishing license to a veteran who was disabled or a
5 prisoner of war during that veteran's military service. The
6 department shall prepare an application to be used by a person
7 requesting a fishing license under this subsection. The
8 veteran affairs division of the department of public defense
9 shall assist the department in verifying the status or claims
10 of applicants under this subsection. As used in this
11 subsection, "veteran" means a person who served in the armed
12 forces of the United States of America at any time during
13 World War I between the dates of April 6, 1917, and June 2,
14 1921, World War II between the dates of December 7, 1941, and
15 December 31, 1946, the Korean conflict between the dates of
16 June 25, 1950, and January 31, 1955, or the Vietnam conflict
17 between August 5, 1965, and May 7, 1975, all dates inclusive,
18 and "disabled" means entitled to compensation under the United
19 States Code, title 38, chapter 11.

20 EXPLANATION

21 This bill provides that veterans of the United States armed
22 forces who served during World War I, World War II, the Korean
23 Conflict, and the Vietnam Conflict and who were disabled or
24 taken prisoner of war, are entitled to free fishing licenses.

FISCAL NOTE

A fiscal note for SENATE FILE 2064 as amended by S-5004 is hereby submitted pursuant to Joint Rule 17. Data used in developing this fiscal note is available from the Legislative Fiscal Bureau to members of the Legislature upon request.

Senate File 2064, as amended by S-5004, provides free hunting and fishing combination licenses for veterans who are disabled due to war-related activities.

Assumptions

1. There are 15,000 disabled veterans who will qualify for the free license.
2. Disabled veterans hunt and fish at a rate equal to 1.5 times the average rate for all Iowans.
3. 10.1% of Iowans purchase fishing licenses (\$8 per license).
4. 4.6% of Iowans purchase hunting licenses (\$8 per license).
5. 2.8% of Iowans purchase combination licenses (\$15 per license).

Fiscal Effect

Senate File 2064, as amended by S-5004, would have an annual fiscal effect of \$36,000 per year. Because the bill would become effective on July 1, 1990, the Department would be placed into the situation of having to issue free licenses in the middle of the 1990 license year.
