5 A person shall not sell, offer for sale, or distribute  
6 teasel (*Dipsacus*) biennial, the multiflora rose (*rosa*  
7 multiflora), purple loosestrife (*lythrum salicaria*), or seeds  
8 of them in any form in this state. However, this section does  
9 not prohibit the multiflora-rose-(rosa-multiflora)-may-be  
10 sold,-offered-for-sale,-or-distributed-when sale, offer for  
11 sale, or distribution of the multiflora rose (rosa multiflora)  
12 used for understock for either cultivated roses or ornamental  
13 shrubs in gardens. This section also does not prohibit the  
14 sale, offer for sale, or distribution of varieties of the  
15 purple loosestrife (lythrum salicaria) which are sterile  
16 according to a list published by the state weed commissioner  
17 pursuant to chapter 17A. Any person violating the provisions  
18 of this section is subject to a fine of not exceeding one  
19 hundred dollars.

20 EXPLANATION

21 This bill provides that varieties of the weed "purple  
22 loosestrife" which are sterile, according to a list published  
23 by the state weed commissioner, are not subject to section  
24 317.25 which prohibits the sale, offer for sale, or  
25 distribution of the weed.

AN ACT

PROVIDING FOR THE SALE, OFFER FOR SALE, OR DISTRIBUTION OF STERILE VARIETIES OF PURPLE LOOSESTRIFE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 317.25, Code Supplement 1989, is amended to read as follows:

317.25 TEASEL, MULTIFLORA ROSE, AND PURPLE LOOSESTRIFE PROHIBITED.

A person shall not sell, offer for sale, or distribute teasel (*Dipsacus*) biennial, the multiflora rose (*rosa multiflora*), purple loosestrife (*lythrum salicaria*), or seeds of them in any form in this state. However, this section does not prohibit the multiflora-rose-(*rosa-multiflora*)-may-be sold, offered-for-sale, or distributed when sale, offer for sale, or distribution of the multiflora rose (*rosa multiflora*) used for understock for either cultivated roses or ornamental shrubs in gardens. This section also does not prohibit the sale, offer for sale, or distribution of varieties of the purple loosestrife (*lythrum virgatum*) when used for ornamental gardens, and which are sterile according to a list published by the state weed commissioner pursuant to chapter 17A. Any person violating the provisions of this section is subject to a fine of not exceeding one hundred dollars.
