1 Section 1. Section 109.130, subsection 1, Code 1989, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 1. For each elk, antelope, buffalo, or moose, one two
4 thousand five hundred dollars.

5384 5 Sec. 2. Section 110.21, Code 1989, is amended by adding
6 the following new unnumbered paragraph:

7 NEW UNNUMBERED PARAGRAPH. In addition to other civil and
8 criminal penalties imposed for illegally taking or possessing
9 an elk, antelope, buffalo, or moose, the court shall revoke
10 the hunting license of a violator. The violator shall not be
11 allowed to procure a hunting license for the next two calendar
12 years.

13 EXPLANATION

14 This bill increases the civil damages awarded the state for
15 the illegal taking or possessing of an elk, antelope, buffalo,
16 or moose from \$1,000 to \$2,500. The court shall also revoke
17 the hunting license of a violator and the violator is
18 ineligible to have a hunting license in this state for the
19 next two calendar years.
