1 Section 1. Section 204.206, subsection 3, Code 1989, is  
2 amended by adding the following new paragraph and relettering  
3 the subsequent paragraphs:

4 NEW PARAGRAPH. f. Carfentanil.

5 Sec. 2. Section 204.206, subsection 7, Code 1989, is  
6 amended to read as follows:

7 7. HALLUCINOGENIC SUBSTANCES. Unless specifically  
8 excepted or unless listed in another schedule, any material,  
9 compound, mixture, or preparation which contains any quantity  
10 of the following substances:

11 a. ~~Marijuana is deemed to be a schedule II substance~~ when  
12 used for medicinal purposes pursuant to rules of the board of  
13 pharmacy examiners.

14 b. Dronabinol (synthetic) in sesame oil and encapsulated  
15 in a soft gelatin capsule in a United States food and drug  
16 administration approved drug product. [Some other names for  
17 dronabinol ~~(6aR-trans)-6a (6aR-trans)-6a, 7, 8, 10a-~~  
18 ~~tetrahydro-6, 6, 9-trimethyl-3-pentyl-6H-dibenzo~~ 9-trimethyl-  
19 3-pentyl-6H-dibenzo [b,d] pyran-1-01, or ~~(+)-delta (-)-delta~~  
20 9-(trans)-tetrahydrocannabinol.]

21 c. Nabilone [another name for nabilone: ~~(+)-trans-3-~~  
22 ~~(1,1-di-methylheptyl)-6, 6a, 7, 8, 10, 10a-hexahydro-1-~~  
23 hydroxy-6,6-dimethyl-9H - dibenzo [b,d] pyran-9-one.

24 EXPLANATION

25 The bill adds carfentanil to the opiates listed in schedule  
26 II of Iowa's uniform controlled substances Act, and also adds  
27 nabilone, a synthetic derivative of chemicals found in  
28 marijuana, to the schedule II list of hallucinogenic  
29 substances, in order to conform Iowa law with the federal  
30 Uniform Controlled Substances Act.

15 in a soft gelatin capsule in a United States food and drug  
16 administration approved drug product. [Some other names for  
17 dronabinol (6aR trans)-6a, 7, 8, 10a-tetrahydro-6, 6, 9-  
18 trimethyl-3 pentyl-6H-dibenzol [b,d] pyran-1-01 or (-) delta  
19 9-(trans)-tetrahydrocannabinol.]

20 c. Nabilone [another name for nabilone:(+)- trans-3-  
21 (1,1-di-methylheptyl)-6, 6a, 7, 8, 10, 10a-hexahydro-1-  
22 hydroxy-6,6-dimethyl-9H - dibenzol [b,d] pyran-9-one].

23 EXPLANATION

24 The bill adds carfentanil to the opiates listed in schedule  
25 II of Iowa's uniform controlled substances Act, and also adds  
26 nabilone, a synthetic derivative of chemicals found in  
27 marijuana, to the schedule II list of hallucinogenic  
28 substances, in order to conform Iowa law with the federal  
29 Uniform Controlled Substances Act.

30 BACKGROUND STATEMENT

31 SUBMITTED BY THE AGENCY

32 These two changes in Iowa Code chapter 204 will bring Iowa  
33 language in conformance with the federal Uniform Controlled  
34 Substances Act. The two substances to be added as schedule II  
35 substances are currently available as pharmaceutical products

1 in Iowa. As such, they need to be incorporated into chapter  
2 204 so that the controls inherent in chapter 204 can be  
3 applied to their distribution. The substance "carfentanil" is  
4 a synthetic morphine-like product. The substance "nabilone"  
5 is a synthetic derivative of chemicals found in marijuana and  
6 is used as an antinauseant.
