A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to and appropriating funds to the department of  
2 human services for programs that benefit at-risk children.  
3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 99E.10, subsection 1, paragraph a, Code  
2 1989, is amended to read as follows:

3 a. (1) An amount equal to one half of one percent of the  
4 gross lottery revenue shall be deposited in a gamblers  
5 assistance fund in the office of the treasurer of state.  
6 Moneys in the fund shall be administered by the director of  
7 human services and used to provide assistance and counseling  
8 to individuals and families experiencing difficulty as a  
9 result of gambling losses and to promote awareness of  
10 "Gamblers Anonymous" and similar assistance programs. For the  
11 fiscal year beginning July 1, 1988, there is appropriated from  
12 the fund to the department of human services the sum of one  
13 hundred twenty-five thousand dollars to be used to establish a  
14 separate reimbursement policy to reimburse providers for  
15 material costs incurred in providing unit dose drug  
16 distribution systems in long-term care facilities. The  
17 department shall seek to implement the recommendation on unit  
18 dose reimbursement when funds become available.

19 (2) For the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1990, there is  
20 transferred from the gamblers assistance fund to an at-risk  
21 children fund created in the office of the treasurer of state  
22 the sum of five hundred thousand dollars. Moneys in the at-  
23 risk children fund are appropriated for the fiscal year  
24 beginning July 1, 1990, to the department of human services to  
25 be used by the department of human services for any program  
26 that the department of human services or any other state  
27 department or agency oversees for the benefit of at-risk  
28 children. Notwithstanding section 8.33, the moneys  
29 appropriated in this subparagraph remaining unencumbered or  
30 unobligated on June 30, 1991, shall not revert to any fund but  
31 shall be available for expenditure by the department of human  
32 services for the following fiscal year for the at-risk  
33 children programs.

34 EXPLANATION

35 The bill appropriates from the gamblers assistance fund

1 \$500,000 to the department of human services for programs that  
2 benefit at-risk children. The moneys may be used for programs  
3 not only overseen by the department of human services but  
4 programs overseen by any other state department or agency.  
5 The appropriation is not subject to reversion.

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
