RELATING TO THE DEFINITION OF A PHYSICIAN FOR THE PURPOSE  
OF THE PRACTICE OF NURSING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 192.1, subsection 6, Code 1991, is amended to read as follows:

6. "Physician" means a person licensed in this state to practice medicine and surgery, osteopathy and surgery, or osteopathy, or a person licensed in this state to practice dentistry or podiatry when acting within the scope of the license. A physician licensed to practice medicine and surgery, osteopathic medicine and surgery, or osteopathy in a state bordering this state shall be considered a physician for purposes of this chapter unless previously determined to be
