AN ACT

TO PERMIT ADVANCED NURSE PRACTITIONERS TO PRESCRIBE NONCONTROLLED SUBSTANCES OR DEVICES UNDER CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 147.107, Code 1991, is amended by adding the following new subsection:

NEW SUBSECTION. 6. Notwithstanding subsection 1, but subject to the limitations contained in subsections 2 and 3, a registered nurse who is licensed and registered as an advanced registered nurse practitioner and who qualifies for and is registered in a recognized nursing specialty, other than the specialty of nurse anesthetist, may prescribe substances or devices that are not controlled substances or devices, if the nurse is engaged in the practice of a nursing specialty, other than that of nurse anesthetist, for which the use of prescription medications and devices is recognized by the board of medical examiners and the board of nursing and the use of the medications and devices is regulated under rules accepted by the board of medical examiners and adopted by the
