**A BILL FOR**

1 An Act relating to prisoner of war and congressional medal of  
2 honor special motor vehicle registration plates.

1 Section 1. Section 321.34, subsection 8, Code Supplement  
2 1991, is amended by adding the following new unnumbered  
3 paragraph:

4 NEW UNNUMBERED PARAGRAPH. The surviving spouse of a person  
5 who was issued special plates under this subsection may  
6 continue to use the special plates subject to registration of  
7 the special plates in the surviving spouse's name and upon  
8 payment of the fifteen dollar annual registration fee. If the  
9 surviving spouse remarries, the surviving spouse shall return  
10 the special plates to the department and the department shall  
11 issue regular registration plates to the surviving spouse.

12 Sec. 2. Section 321.34, subsection 11, Code Supplement  
13 1991, is amended by adding the following new unnumbered  
14 paragraph:

15 NEW UNNUMBERED PARAGRAPH. The surviving spouse of a person  
16 who was issued special plates under this subsection may  
17 continue to use the special plates subject to registration of  
18 the special plates in the surviving spouse's name and upon  
19 payment of the fifteen dollar annual registration fee. If the  
20 surviving spouse remarries, the surviving spouse shall return  
21 the special plates to the department and the department shall  
22 issue regular registration plates to the surviving spouse.

23 EXPLANATION

24 This bill allows the surviving spouse of a person who was  
25 issued a special prisoner of war or a congressional medal of  
26 honor registration plate to use the plates in the event of the  
27 registrant's death. The surviving spouse must register the  
28 plates in the surviving spouse's own name and is subject to  
29 the special \$15 annual registration fee. If the surviving  
30 spouse remarries, the spouse loses the right to continue to  
31 use the special registration plate.

1 Amend Senate File 2006 as follows:

2 1. By striking everything after the enacting  
3 clause and inserting the following:

4 "Section 1. Section 321.34, Code Supplement 1991,  
5 is amended by adding the following new subsection:  
6 NEW SUBSECTION. 15. PLATES RETAINED BY SURVIVING  
7 SPOUSE.

8 The department may adopt rules to provide for the  
9 retention of a special registration plate issued under  
10 subsection 8, 11, 12, or 13 when the owner of the  
11 vehicle is deceased and the surviving spouse would  
12 like to retain the special registration plate. The  
13 department shall allow the surviving spouse to retain  
14 the plate that does not display the validation  
15 stickers."

16 2. Title page, lines 1 and 2, by striking the  
17 words "prisoner of war and congressional medal of  
18 honor".

1 Amend amendment, S-5094, to Senate File 2006 as  
2 follows:

3 1. Page 1, line 5, by striking the word  
4 "subsection" and inserting the following:  
5 "subsections".

6 2. Page 1, by inserting after line 15 the  
7 following:

8 "NEW SUBSECTION. 16. SILVER OR BRONZE STAR  
9 PLATES. The owner of a motor vehicle subject to  
10 registration pursuant to section 321.109, subsection  
11 1, multipurpose vehicle, light delivery truck, panel  
12 delivery truck, or pickup, who was awarded a silver or  
13 a bronze star by the United States government, may  
14 upon written application to the department and  
15 presentation of satisfactory proof of the award of the  
16 silver or bronze star, order special registration  
17 plates. The design of the plate shall include a  
18 representation of a silver or bronze star centered on  
19 the left side of the plate. The plates shall be  
20 numbered in sequence beginning with 00001. The  
21 application is subject to approval by the department  
22 in consultation with the adjutant general. The  
23 special registration plates shall be issued to the  
24 applicant in exchange for the registration plates  
25 previously issued to that person. The fee for the  
26 silver or bronze star plates shall be twenty-five  
27 dollars which shall be in addition to the regular  
28 annual registration fee. The department shall  
29 validate the special plates in the same manner as  
30 regular registration plates are validated under this  
31 section.""
