2 are amended to read as follows:

13 The bill changes the acts and offenses by professional

17 permits such disciplinary actions for conviction of any
18 felony. Under current law, the felony must be related to the
19 registrant's profession or occupation or affect the
20 registrant's ability to practice before the registrant felon
21 is subject to disciplinary proceedings by the board.

26 BACKGROUND STATEMENT

27 SUBMITTED BY THE AGENCY

28 After reviewing the provisions of Iowa Code section 114.21,
29 the engineering and land surveying examining board believes
30 that the language in Iowa Code section 116.21, concerning
31 disciplinary actions by the accountancy examining board, is
32 more appropriate. Thus, the bill conforms this subsection to
33 language used in section 116.21.
