1 Section 1. Section 12.21, Code 1991, is amended to read as
2 follows:

3 12.21 ACCEPTING CREDIT CARD PAYMENTS.

4 The treasurer of state may enter into an agreement with a
5 financial institution to provide credit card receipt
6 processing for state departments which are authorized by the
7 treasurer of state to accept payment by credit card. A
8 department which accepts credit card payments may adjust its
9 fees to reflect the cost of processing as determined by the
10 treasurer of state. A fee may be charged by a department for
11 using the credit card payment method notwithstanding any other
12 provision of the Code setting specific fees. The treasurer of
13 state shall adopt rules to implement this section.

14 EXPLANATION

15 This bill requires that in order for a state department to
16 accept payments by credit card through an agreement between
17 the treasurer of state and a financial institution, the
18 treasurer of state must authorize the department to do so.
19 Current law does not specify the entity which is required to
20 authorize a department to accept payments by credit card.

AN ACT

RELATING TO AUTHORIZATION OF STATE DEPARTMENTS' ACCEPTANCE OF PAYMENTS BY CREDIT CARD.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 12.21, Code 1991, is amended to read as follows:

12.21 ACCEPTING CREDIT CARD PAYMENTS.

The treasurer of state may enter into an agreement with a financial institution to provide credit card receipt processing for state departments which are authorized by the treasurer of state to accept payment by credit card. A department which accepts credit card payments ~~may~~ shall adjust its fees to reflect the cost of processing as determined by the treasurer of state. A fee may be charged by a department for using the credit card payment method notwithstanding any other provision of the Code setting specific fees. The
