1 Section 1. Section 159A.4, subsection 1, Code Supplement  
2 1991, is amended to read as follows:

3 1. A renewable fuel advisory committee is established  
4 within the department. The committee shall be composed of the  
5 following persons:

6 a. The secretary, or a person designated by the secretary,  
7 representing the department of agriculture and land  
8 stewardship, who shall be the chairperson of the committee.

9 b. The director of the Iowa department of economic  
10 development, or a person designated by the director,  
11 representing the Iowa department of economic development.

12 c. The director of the state department of transportation,  
13 or a person designated by the director, representing the state  
14 department of transportation.

15 d. The director of the department of natural resources, or  
16 a person designated by the director, representing the  
17 department of natural resources.

18 d e. A person representing retail dealers as defined in  
19 section 214A.1 who shall be actively engaged in the business  
20 of selling motor vehicle fuel on a retail basis.

33 The governor shall appoint persons who shall be confirmed  
34 by the senate, pursuant to section 2.32, to serve as voting  
35 members of the committee. However, the secretary of

1 agriculture shall appoint the person representing the  
2 department of agriculture and land stewardship, the director  
3 of the Iowa department of economic development shall appoint  
4 the person representing that department, and the director of  
5 the state department of transportation shall appoint the  
6 person representing that department, and the director of the  
7 department of natural resources shall appoint the person  
8 representing that department. The governor may make  
9 appointments of persons representing organizations listed  
10 under paragraphs "f" "g" and "g" "h" from a list of candidates  
11 which shall be provided by the organization upon request by  
12 the governor.

13 Sec. 2. Section 159A.4, subsection 2, Code Supplement  
14 1991, is amended to read as follows:

15 2. The members appointed pursuant to subsection 1,  
16 paragraphs "d" "e" through "h" "i", shall serve three-year  
17 terms beginning and ending as provided in section 69.19.  
18 However, the governor shall appoint initial members to serve  
19 for less than three years to ensure members serve staggered  
20 terms. A member is eligible for reappointment. A vacancy on  
21 the committee shall be filled for the unexpired portion of the  
22 regular term in the same manner as regular appointments are  
23 made.

24 Sec. 3. Section 159A.4, subsection 5, Code Supplement  
25 1991, is amended to read as follows:

26 5. The members other than those enumerated in subsection  
27 i, paragraphs "a" through "e" "d", are entitled to receive  
28 compensation as provided in section 7E.6.

29 EXPLANATION

30 This bill amends section 159A.4 establishing a renewable  
31 fuel advisory committee. The bill adds two persons to the  
32 committee, including the director of the department of natural  
33 resources or the director's designee, and a person appointed  
34 by the governor representing the renewable fuel industry in  
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27 1, paragraphs "a" through "e" "d", are entitled to receive  
28 compensation as provided in section 7E.6.

**A BILL FOR**

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BACKGROUND STATEMENT  
SUBMITTED BY THE AGENCY

The chief purpose of the office of renewable fuel of the department of agriculture and land stewardship is to further the production and consumption of ethanol in this state. It is the consensus of the renewable fuel advisory committee to include additional members to the committee. A representative from the Iowa department of natural resources is added because of expertise and continued work in renewable energies. A representative from the renewable fuel industry is added to complement the base of knowledge of the renewable fuel advisory committee and to keep the committee abreast of the needs of the renewable fuel industry.

SENATE FILE 2221

AN ACT

PROVIDING FOR THE COMPOSITION OF THE RENEWABLE FUEL ADVISORY COMMITTEE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 159A.4, subsection 1, Code Supplement 1991, is amended to read as follows:

1. A renewable fuel advisory committee is established within the department. The committee shall be composed of the following persons:

a. The secretary, or a person designated by the secretary, representing the department of agriculture and land stewardship, who shall be the chairperson of the committee.

b. The director of the Iowa department of economic development, or a person designated by the director, representing the Iowa department of economic development.

c. The director of the state department of transportation, or a person designated by the director, representing the state department of transportation.

d. The director of the department of natural resources, or a person designated by the director, representing the department of natural resources.

d e. A person representing retail dealers as defined in section 214A.1 who shall be actively engaged in the business of selling motor vehicle fuel on a retail basis.

e f. A person representing refiners of petroleum products who shall be actively engaged in the business of refining petroleum into motor vehicle fuel for the purpose of sale within the state.

f g. A person representing an organization serving livestock producers in this state.

g h. A person representing the Iowa corn growers association.

h i. One A person actively engaged in farming, as defined in section 172C.1.

j. A person representing the renewable fuel industry in this state.

The governor shall appoint persons who shall be confirmed by the senate, pursuant to section 2.32, to serve as voting members of the committee. However, the secretary of agriculture shall appoint the person representing the department of agriculture and land stewardship, the director of the Iowa department of economic development shall appoint the person representing that department, and the director of the state department of transportation shall appoint the person representing that department, and the director of the department of natural resources shall appoint the person representing that department. The governor may make appointments of persons representing organizations listed under paragraphs "f" "g" and "g" "h" from a list of candidates which shall be provided by the organization upon request by the governor.

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5. The members other than those enumerated in subsection 1, paragraphs "a" through "e" "d", are entitled to receive compensation as provided in section 7E.6.
