A BILL FOR

1 An Act to exempt nonpublic schools from the vocational education  
2 requirement for grades seven through twelve.  
3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

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SF 2236

1 Section 1. Section 256.11, subsection 4, Code Supplement  
2 1991, is amended to read as follows:

3 4. The following shall be taught in grades seven and  
4 eight: English-language arts; social studies; mathematics;  
5 science; health; human growth and development, family,  
6 consumer, career, and technology education; physical  
7 education; music; and visual art. The health curriculum shall  
8 include the characteristics of sexually transmitted diseases  
9 and acquired immune deficiency syndrome. The state board as  
10 part of accreditation standards shall adopt curriculum  
11 definitions for implementing the program in grades seven and  
12 eight. However, family, consumer, career, and technology  
13 education are not required to be taught in nonpublic schools  
14 ~~which-do-not-offer-vocational-education-programs.~~

15 Sec. 2. Section 256.11, subsection 5, paragraph h,  
16 unnumbered paragraph 1, Code Supplement 1991, is amended to  
17 read as follows:

18 A minimum of three sequential units in at least four of the  
19 following six vocational service areas: agriculture, business  
20 or office occupations, health occupations, ~~consumer-and~~ family  
21 and consumer sciences or home economics occupations,  
22 industrial technology or trade and industrial education, and  
23 marketing education. Instruction shall be competency-based,  
24 articulated with postsecondary programs of study, and include  
25 field, laboratory, or on-the-job training. Each sequential  
26 unit shall include instruction in a minimum set of  
27 competencies established by the department of education that  
28 relate to the following: new and emerging technologies; job-  
29 seeking, job-adaptability, and other employment, self-  
30 employment and entrepreneurial skills that reflect current  
31 industry standards and labor-market needs; and reinforcement  
32 of basic academic skills. The instructional programs shall  
33 also comply with the provisions of chapter 258 relating to  
34 vocational education. However, this subsection does not apply

1 programs.

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EXPLANATION

3 This bill exempts all nonpublic schools from the vocational  
4 education standard for grades seven through 12. Current Code  
5 language exempts only those nonpublic schools which do not

AN ACT

TO EXEMPT NONPUBLIC SCHOOLS FROM THE REGULAR VOCATIONAL EDUCATION STANDARDS FOR GRADES SEVEN THROUGH TWELVE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 256.11, subsection 4, Code Supplement 1991, is amended to read as follows:

4. The following shall be taught in grades seven and eight: English-language arts; social studies; mathematics; science; health; human growth and development, family, consumer, career, and technology education; physical education; music; and visual art. The health curriculum shall include the characteristics of sexually transmitted diseases and acquired immune deficiency syndrome. The state board as part of accreditation standards shall adopt curriculum definitions for implementing the program in grades seven and eight. However, this subsection shall not apply to the

teaching of family, consumer, career, and technology education are not required to be taught in nonpublic schools which do not offer vocational education programs.

Sec. 2. Section 256.11, subsection 5, paragraph h, unnumbered paragraph 1, Code Supplement 1991, is amended to read as follows:

A minimum of three sequential units in at least four of the following six vocational service areas: agriculture, business or office occupations, health occupations, ~~consumer and family and consumer~~ sciences or home economics occupations, industrial technology or trade and industrial education, and marketing education. Instruction shall be competency-based, articulated with postsecondary programs of study, and include field, laboratory, or on-the-job training. Each sequential unit shall include instruction in a minimum set of competencies established by the department of education that relate to the following: new and emerging technologies; job-seeking, job-adaptability, and other employment, self-employment and entrepreneurial skills that reflect current industry standards and labor-market needs; and reinforcement of basic academic skills. The instructional programs shall also comply with the provisions of chapter 258 relating to vocational education. However, this subsection paragraph does not apply to the teaching of vocational education in nonpublic schools which do not offer vocational education programs.

Sec. 3. NEW SECTION. 256.11B VOCATIONAL EDUCATION INSTRUCTION -- NONPUBLIC SCHOOLS.

A nonpublic school which provides an educational program that includes grades nine through twelve shall offer and teach five units of occupational education subjects, which may include, but are not limited to, programs, services, and activities which prepare students for employment in business or office occupations, trade and industrial occupations, consumer and family sciences or home economics occupations, agriculture occupations, marketing occupations, and health

occupations. By July 1, 1993, instruction shall be competency-based, articulated with postsecondary programs of study, and may include field, laboratory, or on-the-job training.
