**A BILL FOR**

1 An Act establishing a layperson defibrillation program and  
2 appropriating funds.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

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*SF 2242*

1 Section 1. NEW SECTION. 147.162 LAYPERSON DEFIBRILLATION  
2 PROGRAM -- TRAINING AND EQUIPMENT.

3 1. "Automated external defibrillator" means a device which  
4 interprets cardiac rhythms and delivers electric shocks,  
5 permitting defibrillation by individuals with minimal  
6 training.

7 2. The department shall establish rules pursuant to this  
8 chapter for the certification, training, and use of an  
9 automated external defibrillator by individuals not otherwise  
10 licensed or certified for the use of the device. The rules  
11 shall specify the standards which shall apply to all  
12 individuals issued a prescription under a protocol for the use  
13 of automated external defibrillators on patients not  
14 specifically identified when the physician established the  
15 protocol and prescribed the device. Only those individuals  
16 who are certified under this section may be issued a  
17 prescription authorizing them to use an automated external  
18 defibrillator on patients not specifically identified when the  
19 prescription is issued.

20 Sec. 2. There is appropriated from the general fund of the  
21 state to the department of public health for the fiscal year  
22 beginning July 1, 1992, and ending June 30, 1993, the  
23 following amount, or so much thereof as is necessary, to be  
24 used for the purpose designated:

25 For grants awarded on a competitive basis for the purchase  
26 of automated external defibrillators by organizations owning  
27 or operating sites where large numbers of people gather,  
28 including but not limited to shopping malls, sports  
29 facilities, and office buildings:

30 ..... \$ 100,000

31 EXPLANATION

32 This bill establishes a layperson defibrillation program in  
33 the department of public health. The department is directed  
34 to establish rules regarding the standards for training and  
35 certification of individuals to use automated external

1 defibrillators. The bill also appropriates \$100,000 to the  
2 department to be awarded on a competitive grant basis to  
3 organizations owning or operating facilities where large  
4 numbers of people gather, such as shopping malls and sports  
5 complexes, for use in purchasing automated external  
6 defibrillators.

FISCAL NOTE

A fiscal note for Senate File 2242 is hereby submitted pursuant to Joint Rule 17. Data used in developing this fiscal note is available from the Legislative Fiscal Bureau to members of the Legislature upon request.

Senate File 2242 establishes a Layperson Defibrillation Program in the Department of Public Health (DPH). The bill requires the DPH to establish rules regarding the standards for training and certification of individuals to use automated external defibrillators and appropriates \$100,000 for competitive grants to organizations to purchase automated external defibrillators for FY 1993.

ASSUMPTIONS:

1. Approximately 1,000 organizations are eligible for grant funds.
2. Defibrillators cost approximately \$4,000.
3. An Administrative Assistant II position would be needed to implement the Program.
