AN ACT
RELATING TO ESCORTS FOR THE MOVEMENT OF MOBILE HOMES AND OTHER
FACTORY-BUILT STRUCTURES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 321E.8, subsection 4, Code Supplement 1991, is amended to read as follows:

4. All movements of mobile homes and other vehicles the width of which, including any load, exceeds the roadway lane width of the street or highway being traversed, shall be under escort, except that mobile homes and other factory-built structures with an overall width not exceeding sixteen feet six inches shall not be required to have an escort if travel is on an interstate or four-lane highway and if the mobile home or factory-built structure displays an amber revolving light or strobe light on the rear of the mobile home or
