A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to hospital privileges provided certain
2 professionals including certified health service providers in
3 psychology.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

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SF 2002

1 Section 1. Section 135B.7, unnumbered paragraph 2, Code
2 Supplement 1991, is amended to read as follows:

3 The rules shall state that a hospital shall not deny
4 clinical privileges to physicians and surgeons, podiatrists,
5 osteopaths, osteopathic surgeons, or dentists, or certified
6 health service providers in psychology licensed under chapter
7 148, 149, 150, 150A, or 153, or section 154B.7 solely by
8 reason of the license held by the practitioner or solely by
9 reason of the school or institution in which the practitioner
10 received medical schooling or postgraduate training if the
11 medical schooling or postgraduate training was accredited by
12 an organization recognized by the council on postsecondary
13 accreditation or an accrediting group recognized by the United
14 States department of education. A hospital may establish
15 procedures for interaction between a patient and a
16 practitioner. Nothing in the rules shall prohibit a hospital
17 from limiting, restricting, or revoking clinical privileges of
18 a practitioner for violation of hospital rules, regulations,
19 or procedures established under this paragraph, when applied
20 in good faith and in a nondiscriminatory manner. Nothing in
21 this paragraph shall require a hospital to expand the
22 hospital's current scope of service delivery solely to offer
23 the services of a class of providers not currently providing
24 services at the hospital for which provision of services the
25 hospital has not established rules, regulations, and
26 procedures. A grant of clinical privileges to a certified
27 health service provider in psychology licensed under section
28 154B.7 shall not include the admission, treatment, or
29 discharge of persons whose mental illnesses or nervous
30 disorders are primarily of biological etiology.

31 EXPLANATION

32 This bill includes certified health service providers in
33 psychology in the group of practitioners who may not be denied
34 hospital privileges solely on the basis of the license held or
35 professional education received.

1 The bill limits the denial of hospital privileges by
2 allowing a hospital to establish procedures for interaction
3 between a patient and the practitioners included; by allowing
4 a hospital to limit, restrict, or revoke clinical privileges
5 of a practitioner for violations of hospital rules,
6 regulations, or procedures established and applied in good
7 faith and in a nondiscriminatory fashion; and by not requiring
8 a hospital to expand the current scope of service delivery
9 solely to grant privileges to practitioners. The granting of
10 clinical privileges to health service providers in psychology
11 does not include admission, treatment, or discharge of persons
12 whose mental illness or nervous disorders are primarily of
13 biological etiology.

7 153, or 154B, solely by reason of the license held by the
8 practitioner or solely by reason of the school or institution
9 in which the practitioner received medical schooling or
10 postgraduate training if the medical schooling or postgraduate
11 training was accredited by an organization recognized by the
12 council on postsecondary accreditation or an accrediting group
13 recognized by the United States department of education.

14 EXPLANATION

15 This bill includes psychologists in the group of
16 practitioners who may not be denied hospital privileges solely
17 on the basis of the license held or professional education
18 received.

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
