2 paragraph 1, Code Supplement 1991, is amended to read as
3 follows:

4 Eight additional members to be appointed by the governor,
5 subject to confirmation by the senate. One of the members
6 shall be selected to represent private colleges, private
7 universities, and private junior colleges located in the state
8 of Iowa. When appointing this member, the governor shall give
9 careful consideration to any person or persons nominated or
10 recommended by any organization or association of some or all
11 private colleges, private universities, and private junior
12 colleges located in the state of Iowa. One of the members
13 shall be selected to represent community colleges located in
14 the state of Iowa. When appointing this member, the governor
15 shall give careful consideration to any person or persons
16 nominated or recommended by any organization or association of
17 Iowa community colleges. One member shall be enrolled as a
18 student at a board of regents institution, community college,
19 or accredited private institution. One member shall be a
20 representative of a lending institution located in this state.
21 One member shall be a representative of the Iowa student loan
22 liquidity corporation. The other three members, none of whom
23 shall be official board members or trustees of an institution
24 of higher learning or of an association of institutions of
25 higher learning, shall be selected to represent the general
26 public.

28 This bill provides for senate confirmation of the
