1 Section 1. Section 294A.9, unnumbered paragraph 1, Code  
2 1991, is amended to read as follows:

3 Phase II is established to improve the salaries of  
4 teachers. For each fiscal year through the fiscal year  
5 beginning July 1, 1990, the department of education shall  
6 allocate to each school district for the purpose of  
7 implementing phase II a per pupil amount equal to seventy-five  
8 dollars and ninety-three cents multiplied by the district's  
9 certified enrollment and to each area education agency for the  
10 purpose of implementing phase II a per pupil amount equal to  
11 three dollars and fifty-five cents multiplied by the  
12 enrollment served in the area education agency.

11 EXPLANATION

12 This bill provides additional funding on a per pupil basis  
13 under phase II of the teacher excellence program for paying  
14 the costs of five additional teaching contract work days for  
15 teachers employed by school districts and area education  
16 agencies. The funding under phase II comes from phase III  
17 funds.

SENATE FILE 2319  
FISCAL NOTE

A fiscal note for Senate File 2319 is hereby submitted pursuant to Joint Rule 17. Data used in developing this fiscal note is available from the Legislative Fiscal Bureau to members of the Legislature upon request.

Senate File 2319 makes modifications to Phase II and Phase III of the Educational Excellence Program, by providing additional Phase II funds for additional teaching contract work days under the district and Area Education Agency (AEA) contracts. Districts would receive an additional \$63.25 multiplied by its certified enrollment. AEAs would receive an additional \$2.70 multiplied by the number of students served in the AEA.

Assumptions:

- \* The 1991 certified enrollment for districts is 491,448. This is the figure that would be used for the FY 1993 budget year.
- \* The additional amount received by the districts is equal to \$63.25 multiplied by 491,448, or \$31,084,086.
- \* The number of students served by the AEAs for FY 1993 is 536,872.
- \* The additional amount received by AEAs is equal to \$2.70 multiplied by 536,872, or \$1,449,554.
- \* No modifications are made to the current standing appropriation for the Education Excellence Program, so total state expenditures are not changed.

Fiscal Effect:

This legislation would have no General Fund impact because it does not modify the current standing appropriation for the Education Excellence Program. It does however, shift \$32,533,630 from the allocation for Phase III to the allocation for Phase II.
