1 Section 1. Section 256.11A, subsection 2, Code 1993, is  
2 amended to read as follows:

3 2. Schools and school districts are not required to meet  
4 the requirement stated in the standards adopted by the state  
5 board under section 256.17, Code Supplement 1987, that  
6 prohibits an individual who is employed or contracted as  
7 superintendent from also serving as a principal in that school  
8 or school district until July 1, 1990, except as otherwise  
9 provided in this subsection. Not later than January 1, 1990,  
10 for the school year beginning July 1, 1990, the board of  
11 directors of a school district or authorities in charge of a  
12 nonpublic school, may file a written request with the  
13 department of education that the department waive the  
14 requirement for that district or school. The procedures  
15 specified in subsection 5 apply to the request.  
16 Notwithstanding the standards adopted by the state board under  
17 section 256.17, Code Supplement 1987, an individual who is  
18 employed or contracted as a superintendent by a school or  
19 school district may also serve as an elementary principal in  
20 the school or school district.

21 EXPLANATION

22 This bill permits school or school district superintendents  
23 to serve concurrently as an elementary school principal in the  
24 same school or school district.
