1 Section 1. Section 35A.2, subsection 1, Code 1993, is  
2 amended to read as follows:

3 1. A commission of veterans affairs is created consisting  
4 of seven persons who shall be appointed by the governor,  
5 subject to confirmation by the senate. Members shall be  
6 appointed to staggered terms of four years beginning and  
7 ending as provided in section 69.19. The governor shall fill  
8 a vacancy for the unexpired portion of the term.

9 Sec. 2. 1992 Iowa Acts, chapter 1140, Senate File 2011,  
10 section 41, is amended to read as follows:

11 SEC. 41. TRANSITION. The five members of the commission  
12 of the veterans affairs division of the department of public  
13 defense abolished by this Act serving unexpired terms on the  
14 effective date of this Act may serve as members of the  
15 commission of veterans affairs established under section 35A.3  
16 ~~until the expiration of the terms~~ April 30 of the year in  
17 which the terms ~~to which they were appointed as members of the~~  
18 ~~commission of the veterans affairs division of the department~~  
19 ~~of public defense~~ expire. The sixth and seventh members shall  
20 serve until ~~June~~ April 30, 1996. Their successors shall be  
21 appointed as provided in section 35A.2. A commission member  
22 is eligible for reappointment.

23 EXPLANATION

24 This bill provides that appointees to the state veterans  
25 affairs commission serve terms that begin on May 1 in the year  
26 of appointment, and expire at midnight on April 30 in the year  
27 of expiration.
