**A BILL FOR**

1 An Act limiting the number of terms a person may serve as Iowa  
2 secretary of agriculture and providing an applicability date.  
3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 39.9, Code 1993, is amended by adding  
2 the following new unnumbered paragraph:

3 NEW UNNUMBERED PARAGRAPH. A person shall not be elected to  
4 the office of secretary of agriculture more than three  
5 consecutive times. If a person serves three or more years of  
6 a term to which some other person was elected, the partial  
7 term shall be included as a consecutive election.

8 Sec. 2. This Act applies to terms of office beginning on  
9 or after January 1, 1999.

10 EXPLANATION

11 This bill limits to three the consecutive number of terms a  
12 person may be elected to the office of Iowa secretary of agri-  
13 culture. An appointive term of three or more years is  
14 included as a consecutive election. The bill applies to terms  
15 of office beginning on or after January 1, 1999.
