1 Section 1. Section 481A.24, Code 1993, is amended to read
2 as follows:

3 481A.24 USE OF MOBILE TRANSMITTER PROHIBITED.

4 1. A person who is hunting shall not use a mobile radio
5 transmitter to communicate the location or direction of game
6 or fur-bearing animals or to co-ordinate the movement of other
7 hunters except as otherwise provided in this section.

8 2. ~~This section~~ Subsection 1 does not apply to the hunting
9 of coyotes ~~from January 1 through March 31~~ except during the
10 shotgun deer season as designated by the commission under
11 section 481A.38.

12 3. Subsection 1 does not apply to persons using dogs to
13 hunt coyotes if the following conditions are met:

14 a. All persons in the hunting party have the required
15 licenses, stamps, and field trial permits.

16 b. During a designated shotgun deer season, a member of a
17 hunting party does not carry a firearm and a firearm is not
18 present in any vehicle used by the hunting party.

19 4. A one-way mobile radio transmitter may be used to find
20 or recover dogs or free flying licensed birds of prey.

21 EXPLANATION

22 This bill authorizes the use of mobile radio transmitters
23 while hunting coyotes except during the designated shotgun
24 deer season. However, if a hunting party is using dogs to
25 hunt coyotes, one-way and two-way mobile radio transmitters
26 may be used if the members of the hunting party have the
27 required licenses and permits and, during the designated
28 shotgun deer season, the members are not carrying firearms
29 personally or in their vehicles. Also, a one-way mobile radio
30 transmitter may be used to find or recover dogs or free flying
31 licensed birds of prey. Violators are subject to a scheduled
32 fine of \$25.
