1 Section 1. Section 56.15A, Code 1993, is amended to read
2 as follows:

3 56.15A PROHIBITING CERTAIN CONTRIBUTIONS DURING-THE
4 LEGISLATIVE-SESSION.

5 A lobbyist ~~or-political-committee,-other-than-a-state~~
6 ~~statutory-political-committee,-county-statutory-political~~
7 ~~committee,-or-a-national-political-party,~~ shall not contribute
8 to, act as an agent or intermediary for contributions to, or
9 arrange for the making of contributions to the campaign funds
10 of an elected state official, member of the general assembly,
11 or candidate for public office on the state level on any day
12 during the regular legislative session and, in the case of the
13 governor or a gubernatorial candidate, during the thirty days
14 following the adjournment of a regular legislative session
15 allowed for the signing of bills. A political committee,
16 other than a state statutory political committee, county
17 statutory political committee, or a national political party,
18 shall not contribute to, act as an agent or intermediary for
19 contributions to, or arrange for the making of contributions
20 to a candidate for state office or to the candidate's
21 committee of a candidate for state office.

22 PARAGRAPH DIVIDED. This section shall not apply to the
23 solicitation or receipt of contributions by an elected state
24 official, member of the general assembly, or other state
25 official who has taken affirmative action to seek nomination
26 or election to a federal elective office.

27 EXPLANATION

28 This bill prohibits political committees which are not
29 state or county statutory political committees or national
30 political parties from making contributions directly or
31 indirectly to candidates or candidates' committees.
