A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to the formation of the friends of capitol hill
2 nonprofit corporation.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

SF 312

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1 Section 1. NEW SECTION. 18A.11 FRIENDS OF CAPITOL HILL -
2 - AUTHORIZED CORPORATION.

3 1. The friends of capitol hill corporation shall be
4 incorporated under chapter 504A. The corporation shall be
5 organized and operated for the preservation, restoration, and
6 public use of the Iowa state capitol building, and for related
7 charitable, cultural, and educational purposes.

8 The corporation shall not be regarded as a state agency and
9 a state official or employee, acting in the official's or
10 employee's official capacity, shall not be an incorporator of
11 the corporation.

12 2. The membership of the board of directors of the
13 corporation shall be determined in accordance with the
14 articles of incorporation of the corporation and shall include
15 at least one member from each of the legislative, executive,
16 and judicial branches of government, in addition to public
17 members. Members of the board shall not be entitled in the
18 performance of their duties to either a per diem or expenses.

19 3. In addition to the powers conferred on the board under
20 chapter 504A, the board may accept contributions, including
21 but not limited to appropriations, gifts, grants, loans,
22 services, or other aid or assistance from public or private
23 entities.

24 EXPLANATION

25 This bill authorizes the formation of a friends of capitol
26 hill nonprofit corporation for the preservation, restoration,
27 and public use of the capitol and for related charitable,
28 cultural, and educational purposes. The bill also provides
29 that the board of directors, in accordance with the corporate
30 articles, shall consist of at least one representative of the
31 legislative, executive, and judicial branches of government in
32 addition to public members. The bill also provides the board
33 with the authority to accept appropriations, gifts, services,
34 and contributions of whatever kind from public and private
35 entities.

RELATING TO THE FORMATION OF THE FRIENDS OF CAPITOL HILL NON-PROFIT CORPORATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. NEW SECTION. 18A.11 FRIENDS OF CAPITOL HILL - AUTHORIZED CORPORATION.

1. The friends of capitol hill corporation shall be incorporated under chapter 504A. The corporation shall be organized and operated for the preservation, restoration, and public use of the Iowa state capitol building, and for related charitable, cultural, and educational purposes.

The corporation shall not be regarded as a state agency and a state official or employee, acting in the official's or employee's official capacity, shall not be an incorporator of the corporation.

2. The membership of the board of directors of the corporation shall be determined in accordance with the articles of incorporation of the corporation and shall include at least one member from each of the legislative, executive, and judicial branches of government, in addition to public members. Members of the board shall not be entitled in the performance of their duties to either a per diem or expenses.

3. In addition to the powers conferred on the board under chapter 504A, the board may accept contributions, including but not limited to appropriations, gifts, grants, loans,
