18 EXPLANATION

19 This bill adds a provision to the definition of
20 governmental bodies covered by the open meetings law to
21 include advisory boards, commissions, committees, task forces,
22 or other bodies created by statute or executive order of the
23 state or political subdivision. Current law includes these
24 entities if they are created by the governor or the general
25 assembly.

26 The bill also provides that each member's vote in a meeting
27 of a governmental body be indicated in the minutes or that the
28 minutes contain sufficient information to indicate the vote of
29 each member present.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 21.2, subsection 1, Code 1993, is amended by adding the following new paragraph:

NEW PARAGRAPH. h. An advisory board, advisory commission, advisory committee, task force, or other body created by statute or executive order of this state or created by an executive order of a political subdivision of this state to develop and make recommendations on public policy issues.

Sec. 2. Section 21.3, unnumbered paragraph 2, Code 1993, is amended to read as follows:

Each governmental body shall keep minutes of all its meetings showing the date, time and place, the members present, and the action taken at each meeting. The minutes shall show the results of each vote taken and the information sufficient to indicate the vote of each member present. The
