A BILL FOR

1 An Act providing for ex officio, nonvoting membership on the  
2 state board of regents and for related matters.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

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SF 414

1 Section 1. Section 262.1, Code 1993, is amended by  
2 striking the section and inserting in lieu thereof the  
3 following:

4 262.1 MEMBERSHIP -- TERM OF OFFICE.

5 1. The state board of regents shall consist of the  
6 following members:

7 a. The following nine public members:

8 (1) Eight members who shall be selected from the state at  
9 large solely with regard to their qualifications and fitness  
10 to discharge the duties of the office.

11 (2) One member who shall be a student enrolled on a full-  
12 time basis in good standing at either the graduate or  
13 undergraduate level at one of the institutions listed in  
14 section 262.7, subsection 1, 2, or 3, at the time of the  
15 member's appointment.

16 b. The following four ex officio, nonvoting members:

17 (1) The chairperson and ranking member of the senate  
18 education appropriations subcommittee.

19 (2) The chairperson and ranking member of the house of  
20 representatives education appropriations subcommittee.

21 2. The public members shall be appointed by the governor  
22 subject to confirmation by the senate. The term of each  
23 public member of the board shall be six years. The terms of  
24 three public members of the board shall begin and expire in  
25 odd-numbered years as provided in section 69.19.

26 Selection of public members shall be in accordance with  
27 sections 69.16 and 69.16A. A vacancy created by a public  
28 member of the board shall be filled for the unexpired term in  
29 the same manner as the original appointment under the  
30 procedures of section 2.32.

31 Sec. 2. NEW SECTION. 262.3 EXPENSES -- FILING AND AUDIT.

32 All claims for the actual necessary expenses of the board  
33 and of its committees, offices, agencies, and employees shall  
34 be filed with and allowed by the director of revenue and  
35 finance in the same manner as required in the case of claims

1 for similar expenses by state officers. Ex officio, nonvoting  
2 legislative members of the board shall be reimbursed for  
3 actual and necessary expenses pursuant to section 2.10,  
4 subsection 5, and section 2.12.

5 Sec. 3. Section 262.4, Code 1993, is amended to read as  
6 follows:

7 262.4 REMOVALS.

8 The governor, with the approval of a majority of the senate  
9 during a session of the general assembly, may remove any a  
10 public member of the board for malfeasance in office, or for  
11 any cause which would render the member ineligible for  
12 appointment or incapable or unfit to discharge the duties of  
13 office, and the member's removal, when so made, shall be  
14 final.

15 Sec. 4. Section 262.5, Code 1993, is amended to read as  
16 follows:

17 262.5 SUSPENSION.

18 When the general assembly is not in session, the governor  
19 may suspend any a public member so disqualified and shall  
20 appoint another to fill the vacancy ~~thus~~ created, subject to  
21 the approval of the senate when next in session.

22 Sec. 5. REPEALS. Sections 262.2, 262.6, and 262.29, Code  
23 1993, are repealed.

24 EXPLANATION

25 The bill expands the membership of the state board of  
26 regents to include as ex officio, nonvoting members the  
27 chairpersons and ranking members of the senate and house of  
28 representatives education appropriations subcommittees. Ex  
29 officio, nonvoting legislative board members shall be reim-  
30 ~~bursed~~ bursed for actual and necessary expenses.

1 Amend Senate File 414 as follows:

2 1. Page 1, by inserting after line 18 the  
3 following:

4 "However, a member who serves as chairperson or  
5 ranking member on the senate education appropriations  
6 subcommittee shall not serve on the board for more  
7 than four consecutive years. If such a member has  
8 served on the board for four consecutive years, and  
9 continues to serve as chairperson or ranking member of  
10 the subcommittee, the majority or minority leader, as  
11 the case may be, shall designate another member of the  
12 senate education appropriations subcommittee to serve  
13 on the board for a term of no more than four  
14 consecutive years."

15 2. Page 1, by inserting after line 20 the  
16 following:

17 "However, a member who serves as the chairperson or  
18 ranking member on the house of representatives  
19 education appropriations subcommittee shall not serve  
20 on the board for more than four consecutive years. If  
21 such a member has served on the board for four  
22 consecutive years, and continues to serve as  
23 chairperson or ranking member of the subcommittee, the  
24 speaker of the house or the minority leader, as the  
25 case may be, shall designate another member of the  
26 house of representatives education appropriations  
27 subcommittee to serve on the board for a term of no  
28 more than four consecutive years."

2 1. Page 1, line 30, by inserting after the figure  
3 "2.32." the following: "The four ex officio,  
4 nonvoting members shall be subject to confirmation by  
5 a majority vote of the voting members of the state  
6 board of regents. If a member of the general assembly  
7 designated pursuant to subsection 1, paragraph "b" is  
8 not confirmed, another member of the general assembly  
9 shall be appointed, subject to the same confirmation  
10 procedure established in this subsection, by either  
11 the majority or minority leader of the senate, or the  
12 speaker or minority leader of the house of  
13 representatives, as applicable. Vacancies shall be  
14 filled and confirmed in the same manner as the  
15 original appointment."
