5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. STATE PERCENT OF GROWTH. There is established
2 pursuant to section 257.8, subsection 1, for the school budget
3 year beginning July 1, 1994, for the state school foundation
4 program a state percent of growth equal to three percent.

5 Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act, being deemed of
6 immediate importance, takes effect upon enactment and is
7 applicable for computing state aid under the state school
8 foundation program for the school budget year beginning July
9 1, 1994.

10 EXPLANATION

11 This bill establishes for the school budget year beginning
12 July 1, 1994, for the state school foundation aid program a
13 state percent of growth equal to 3.0 percent. Section 257.8
14 of the Code, rewritten in 1992, states that the state percent
15 of growth for a budget year be established by statute within
16 30 days of the submission in the base year of the governor's
17 budget to the general assembly. The bill takes effect upon
18 enactment.

Senate File 2041 establishes the state percent of growth for the school budget year beginning July 1, 1994, for the purposes of the state school foundation formula at 3.0%.

ASSUMPTIONS:

1. The allowable growth factor for FY 1995 is 3.0%.
2. The taxable valuation is increased by 1.5% over FY 1994 levels.
3. The basic enrollment increases by 1,697 students from FY 1994.
4. The special education weights increase by 1,168 from FY 1994.
5. The supplemental weights decrease by 1,294 from FY 1994.
6. The budget guarantee is 100% of the previous years regular program district cost and the area education agency special education support services for FY 1995.
7. The School Budget Review Committee decisions for talented and gifted programs, drop out prevention programs, and other one time grants are held constant at FY 1994 levels.
8. Reorganization incentives have been updated for districts that reorganized by July 1, 1993. The estimates for these incentives are preliminary and will not be finalized until taxable valuation is known in late March.

FISCAL EFFECT:

Senate File 2041 is estimated to increase state support of local districts by \$46,500,000 and property tax support of local school districts by \$16,400,000.
