BY COMMITTEE ON NATURAL RESOURCES

A Senate Resolution expressing appreciation and thanks to United States Air Force cadets who assisted with flood cleanup efforts at Ledges State Park and Dolliver State Park.

WHEREAS, the state of Iowa received record levels of rainfall and flooding during the spring and summer of 1993; and

WHEREAS, the flooding caused millions of dollars of damage to private as well as public property throughout the state of Iowa; and

WHEREAS, the plight of the flood victims brought help in the form of materials and volunteers from across the nation; and

WHEREAS, Ledges State Park and Dolliver State Park are important historic natural resources in Iowa's park system and were heavily damaged by floodwaters; and

WHEREAS, one hundred cadets from the United States Air Force Academy located at Colorado Springs, Colorado, participated in a massive cleanup effort from October 15 through October 17, 1993, at Ledges State Park and Dolliver State Park under the direction of the Department of Natural Resources; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE, That the State of Iowa thanks the cadet volunteers from the United States Air Force Academy for their time and efforts as participants in the Ledges State Park and Dolliver State Park flood cleanup, from October 15 through
