1 Section 1. STATEWIDE EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS -- AGRICULTURAL
2 PRODUCTION AND MARKETING CONTRACTS. There is appropriated
3 from the general fund of the state to the office of attorney
4 general for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1997, and ending
5 June 30, 1998, the following amount, or so much thereof as is
6 necessary, to be used for the purpose designated:

7 For the purpose of supporting the environmental and
8 agricultural law division in conducting educational programs
9 around the state regarding production and marketing contracts,
10 including hedge to arrive contracts, involving agricultural
11 commodities, especially grain:
12 \$ 100,000

13 The environmental and agricultural law division shall plan
14 and conduct the educational programs in concert with the Iowa
15 cooperative extension service in agriculture and home
16 economics at Iowa state university. The educational programs
17 shall be carried out in cooperation with interested
18 associations including, but not limited to, the Iowa
19 agribusiness association, the Iowa institute for cooperatives,
20 the Iowa farm bureau federation, and the Iowa corn growers
21 association.

22 EXPLANATION

23 This bill appropriates \$100,000 to the office of attorney
24 general to support the office's environmental and agricultural
25 law division in conducting educational programs around the
26 state regarding production and marketing contracts, including
27 hedge to arrive contracts, involving agricultural commodities,
28 especially grain. The division is required to plan and
29 conduct the educational programs in concert with the Iowa
30 cooperative extension service in agriculture and home
31 economics at Iowa state university. The bill provides that
32 the educational programs must be carried out in cooperation
33 with interested associations.
