2 as follows:

3 321.44A VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTION -- ANATOMICAL GIFT PUBLIC
4 AWARENESS AND TRANSPLANTATION FUND -- AMOUNT RETAINED BY
5 COUNTY TREASURER.

6 For each application for registration or renewal, the
7 county treasurer or the department shall request through use
8 of a written form, and, if the application is made in person,
9 through verbal communication, that an applicant make a
10 voluntary contribution of one dollar or more to the anatomical
11 gift public awareness and transplantation fund established
12 pursuant to section 142C.15. Moneys Ninety-five percent of
13 the moneys collected in the form of contributions shall be
14 remitted to the treasurer of state for deposit in the fund to
15 be used for the purposes specified for the fund. The
16 remaining five percent shall be retained by the county
17 treasurer for deposit in the general fund of the county. The
18 director shall adopt rules to administer this section.

19 EXPLANATION
