The Department of Human Services (DHS) is proposing legislation to change the composition of the Family Development and Self-Sufficiency (FaDSS) Council by adding the Director of Iowa Workforce Development (IWD) or designee to the Council. The Council provides direction and oversight to the provision of family development services to Family Investment Program (FIP) participants with multiple or severe barriers to self-sufficiency who have been referred by PROMISE JOBS to the FaDSS program.

This proposal recognizes the close partnership between Iowa Workforce Development and the FaDSS program. Representation by Iowa Workforce Development on the FaDSS Council will facilitate closer collaboration in provision of services and future planning for the FaDSS program.

This proposal will change Code Section 217.11 which describes composition of the FaDSS Council.
