1 Section 1. Section 23A.2, subsection 10, Code 1997, is
2 amended by adding the following new paragraph:

3 NEW PARAGRAPH. m. The repair, calibration, or maintenance
4 of radiological detection equipment by the emergency
5 management division of the department of public defense.

6 Sec. 2. Section 29C.8, Code 1997, is amended by adding the
7 following new subsection:

8 NEW SUBSECTION. 5. The emergency management division may
9 charge fees for the repair, calibration, or maintenance of
10 radiological detection equipment and may expend funds in
11 addition to funds budgeted for the servicing of the
12 radiological detection equipment. The division shall adopt
13 rules pursuant to chapter 17A providing for the establishment
14 and collection of fees for radiological detection equipment
15 repair, calibration, or maintenance services and for entering
16 into agreements with other public and private entities to
17 provide the services. Fees collected for repair, calibration,
18 or maintenance services shall be treated as repayment receipts
19 as defined in section 8.2 and shall be used for the operation
20 of the division's radiological maintenance facility or
21 radiation incident response training.

22 EXPLANATION

23 This bill exempts the provision of repair, calibration, or
24 maintenance services by the emergency management division of
25 the department of public defense from state law which
26 prohibits state competition with private enterprise. The bill
27 also authorizes the division to charge fees for the provision
28 of repair, calibration, or maintenance services for
29 radiological detection equipment. Fees charged, if any, are
30 to be treated as repayment receipts under section 8.2 and are
31 to be used for the operation of the radiological maintenance
32 facility or for radiation incident response training.

22 EXPLANATION

23 This bill exempts the provision of repair, calibration, or
24 maintenance services by the emergency management division of
25 the department of public defense from state law which
26 prohibits state competition with private enterprise. The bill
27 also authorizes the division to charge fees for the provision
28 of repair, calibration, or maintenance services for
29 radiological detection equipment. Fees charged, if any, are
30 to be treated as repayment receipts under section 8.2 and are
31 to be used for the operation of the radiological maintenance
32 facility or for radiation incident response training.
