TITLE FEES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 321G.15, Code Supplement 1997, is amended to read as follows:

321G.15 OPERATION PENDING REGISTRATION.

The commission shall furnish snowmobile and all-terrain vehicle dealers with pasteboard cards bearing the words "registration applied for" and space for the date of purchase. An unregistered all-terrain vehicle or snowmobile sold by a dealer shall bear one of these cards which entitles the purchaser to operate it for ten days immediately following the purchase. The purchaser of a registered all-terrain vehicle or snowmobile may operate it for ten days immediately following the purchase, without having completed a transfer of registration. A snowmobile or all-terrain vehicle dealer shall make application and pay all registration and title fees
