SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION

A Joint Resolution to nullify an administrative rule of the department of corrections concerning dietary requirements in jails and providing an effective date.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

S.J.R. 4

1 Section 1. 201 Iowa administrative code, rule 50.16,
2 subrule 4, is nullified.

3 Sec. 2. This Joint Resolution, being deemed of immediate
4 importance, takes effect upon enactment.

5 EXPLANATION

6 This Joint Resolution nullifies an administrative rule of
7 the department of corrections applicable to county jails and
8 detention facilities and municipal holding facilities
9 concerning inmate dietary requirements. The rule to be
10 nullified requires that a jail's food service meet or exceed
11 minimum dietary guidelines which shall be certified by a
12 qualified dietitian.

13 The Joint Resolution is effective upon enactment.
