2 paragraph 1, Code 1999, is amended to read as follows:
3 Establish minimum training standards including continuing
4 education requirements, and administer examinations and
5 disciplinary procedures for operators of radiation machines
6 and users of radioactive materials. A state of Iowa license
7 to practice medicine, osteopathy, chiropractic, podiatry,
8 dentistry, dental hygiene, or veterinary medicine, or
9 licensure as a physician assistant pursuant to chapter 148C,
10 or licensure as a registered nurse or a registered nurse
11 practitioner pursuant to chapter 152, or certification by the
12 board of dental examiners in dental radiography, or by the
13 board of podiatry examiners in podiatric radiography, or
14 enrollment in a program or course of study approved by the
15 Iowa department of public health which includes the
16 application of radiation to humans satisfies the minimum
17 training standards for operation of radiation machines only.

18 EXPLANATION

19 This bill provides that licensure as a registered nurse or
20 a registered nurse practitioner satisfies the minimum training
21 standards for operation of radiation machines.
